It is our great pleasure to introduce the first issue of the SCIRES-IT (SCIentific RESearch and Information Technology - Ricerca Scientifica e Tecnologie dell'Informazione).

The Journal has been founded as an expression of the interest of the ITA (Technological Innovation and Accessibility) permanent working Group of CASPUR-CIBER (Interuniversity Committee for Database and E-publishing).

It is published by CASPUR-CIBER Publishing - Pubblicazioni ecosostenibili (http://caspurciberpublishing.it), the publishing service of CASPUR (Interuniversity Consortium for Supercomputing for University and Research) in Rome (Italy), promoted by the same ITA working Group since 2009 for the development of open access publishing and for the preservation and restoration of the natural environment.

CASPUR-CIBER Publishing - Pubblicazioni Ecosostenibili publishes open access scientific, educational and multimedia materials from the Universities within the CASPUR Consortium, and from other public and research institutions. For each publication, an action of environmental restoration will be made in protected areas by planting local ecotypes of native species. The publishing system enhances the development of the institutions' research production, the rationalization of publishing costs, and the open access to publications and their quick dessimination within the national and international scientific community. Each publication is registered into the ISSN, ISBN and DOI international directories.

CASPUR-CIBER Publishing - Pubblicazioni ecosostenibili offers a complete and peerreviewed publishing system, and a Print on Demand service with FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) certified paper.

CASPUR-CIBER Publishing - Pubblicazioni Ecosostenibili puts together the main principles of the Berlin Declaration on Open Acess with the aims of the International Convention on

Biological Diversity, fostering the scientific dissemination, the biodiversity awareness, the environment preservation, and the sustainable use of natural resources.

SCIRES-IT, ISSN 2239-4303, is an Open Access journal providing an international forum for the exchange and sharing of know-how in the areas of Digitalization and Multimedia Technologies and Information & Communication Technology (ICT) in support of Cultural and environmental Heritage (CH) documentation, preservation and fruition. It publishes comprehensive reviews on specific fields, regular research papers and short communications in a timely fashion.

The Journal aim is to encourage scientists to publish their experimental results and theoretical work in a comprehensive way. There are, in addition, other features that this Journal encourages: electronic files regarding the full details of theoretical derivations, detailed experimental results, high-resolution renderings, short video animations and audio/video documentaries can be deposited as supplementary material to support the article.
